	Chuo Main Line	Kasugai to Mizunami Minamikiso to Shiojiri	1. Walk to Kasugai. 2. Go from Owariichinomiya via Gifu, Mino ota, Tajimi to Kasugai. 3. Go from Maibara Sta. by Shinkansen, go from Maibara via Gifu, Mino ota, Tajimi to Kasugai.
	Kansai Main Line	Yokkaichi Kameyama	1. Go to Shinosaka Sta. by Shinkansen and return from Osaka 2. Go to Kyoto Sta. by Shinkansen and return from Kyoto 3. Walk to Yokkaichi Station
Meitetsu	Nagoya Main Line	Sugaguchi	1. Walk from Sugaguchi Station
	Tsushima Bisai Line	Morikami	1. All lines closed 2. Walk to Morikami Station 3. Transfer from Morikami Station to Meitetsu Ichinomiya Station and return on the Bisai Line.
Kintetsu	Nagoya Line	Tomisuhara	1. Go to Shinosaka Sta. by Shinkansen and return on the Kintetsu Line 2. Transfer from the Shinkansen at Kyoto and return on the Kintetsu Line 3. Walk to Tomisuhara Station

This map has been prepared to assist persons returning home on foot when the transportation facilities are stopped for example which happened when the warning announcement was issued during the Tokai earthquake. Although this map indicates roads, the safety of those roads cannot be guaranteed. Please take precautions for your safety when using the roads.

Response to an Earthquake warning (in the designated Areas under Intensified Measures)

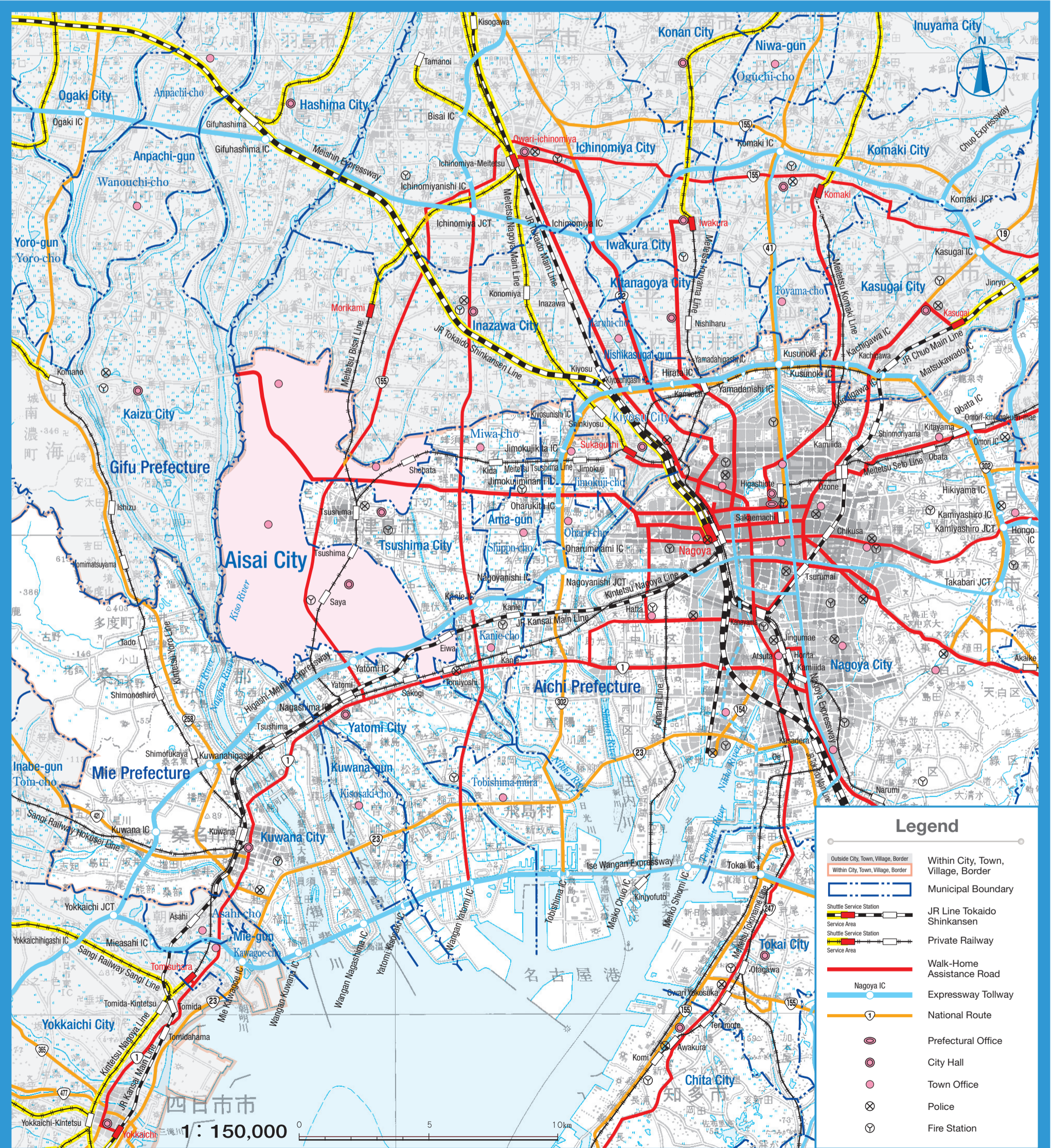
Railway and Subway
 • Railway and subway operations are not allowed in the Areas under Intensified Measures. Trains stop at the nearest safe stations.
 • Railway and subway operations are allowed in the areas where the earthquake intensity level is below 6 and no tsunami occurs, when it is determined that the trains can be operated safely. * JR Tokai Shinkansen provides services between Nagoya and Shin-Osaka.

Bus and Taxi
 Bus and taxi services stop (drivers pull over at safe places and guide passengers on how to get to evacuation center).

When a warning announcement has been issued for an earthquake:
 • Do not approach concrete-block walls or unstable vending machines.
 • Pay attention to buildings for falling window glass or signs. Do not approach such buildings.
 Take care to ensure your safety.
