



Assistance Map for Returning Home on Foot

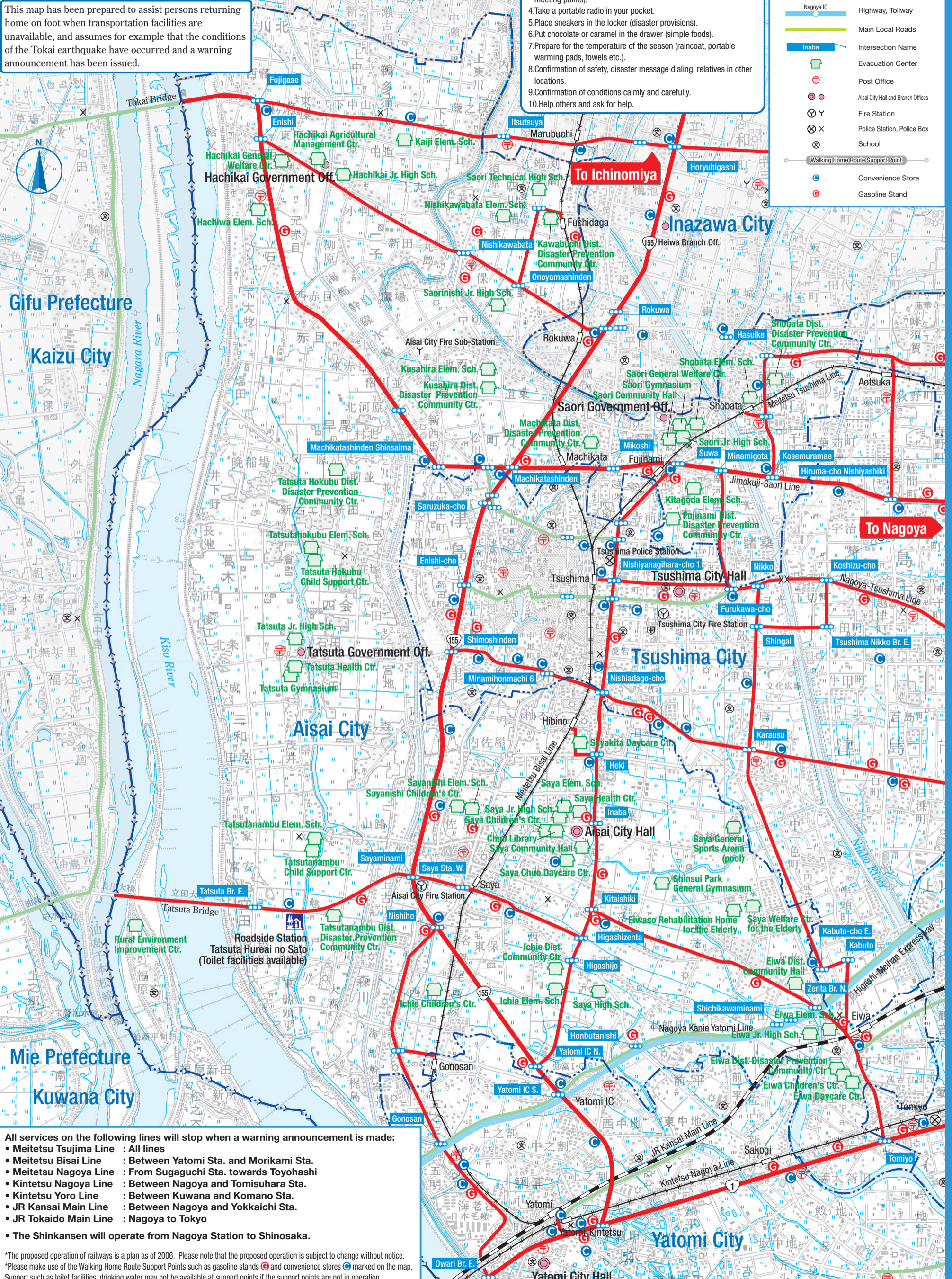
This map has been prepared to assist persons returning home on foot when transportation facilities are unavailable, and assumes for example that the conditions of the Tokai earthquake have occurred and a warning announcement has been issued.

10 Points to Remember to Avoid Difficulties Getting Home

1. Make a map to show the way home.
2. Practice walking home.
3. Discuss matters with your family in advance (means of contact, meeting points).
4. Take a portable radio in your pocket.
5. Place sneakers in the locker (disaster provisions).
6. Put chocolate or caramel in the drawer (simple foods).
7. Prepare for the temperature of the season (raincoat, portable warming pads, towels etc.).
8. Confirmation of safety, disaster message dialing, relatives in other locations.
9. Confirmation of conditions calmly and carefully.
10. Help others and ask for help.

All services on the following lines will stop when a warning announcement is made:

- Meitetsu Tsujima Line : All lines
- Meitetsu Bisai Line : Between Yatomi Sta. and Morikami Sta.
- Meitetsu Nagoya Line : From Sugaguchi Sta. towards Toyohashi
- Kintetsu Nagoya Line : Between Nagoya and Tomisuhara Sta.
- Kintetsu Yoro Line : Between Kuwana and Komano Sta.
- JR Kansai Main Line : Between Nagoya and Yokkaichi Sta.
- JR Tokaido Main Line : Nagoya to Tokyo

• The Shinkansen will operate from Nagoya Station to Shinosaka.
